



### **Fellowship Applicant Guide**

The following serves to elaborate on the criteria specified in Sect. 2(A) in the by-laws of the Society. The Fellowship committee will use these guidelines to determine eligibility for fellowship in the Society.

Active Fellow candidates shall have been an active member in good standing of the Society for at least five years

Candidates applying for eligible by virtue of being first author of at least eight significant papers on cardiovascular and interventional subjects under Sect. 2(A)2(a) must have their papers conform to the following criteria:

1. Were published in a major, large circulation, peer review journal such as JVIR, Radiology, AJR or other specialty journal with similar prestige.
2. Recognized in editorials or by leaders in the field as a significant contribution.

Candidates applying by virtue of being an exceptional leader or teacher under Sect. 2(A)2(c) must satisfy one or more the following examples:

1. Leadership roles may include chairing Society committees, representing the Society at other nationally recognized medical organizations, leadership roles in other national or state recognized medical organizations.
2. Participation in political activities on behalf of the field of Vascular and Interventional Radiology.
3. A long history of participation as a teacher at continuing medical education conferences.

In evaluating candidates for Fellowship through this path, the Fellows committee will review the totality of the candidate's contributions on behalf of Vascular and Interventional Radiology. It should be understood by the candidate that Fellowship will be awarded for a long and consistent set of activities.
