*Applicants must show an interest in or possess plans to develop IR educational, informational or collaborative programs and must possess adequate English language skills to derive benefit from meeting attendance. Exclusions include Annual Scientific Meeting faculty/scientific program presenters. Applicants may not have attended the SIR Annual Scientific Meeting in the past three years.**
