

SIR ANNUAL MEMBERS' BUSINESS MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, APRIL 14, 2026
Toronto, ON – in conjunction with SIR 2026

Welcome and Introductions

- Dr. Robert Lookstein, SIR President, welcomed attendees, acknowledged weather-related travel challenges, and called the meeting to order at 7:04 am ET.
- The membership paused for a moment of silence in remembrance of SIR past presidents and members who had passed away during the year.
- Dr. Kelvin Hong, MD, FSIR, SIR Secretary, reviewed the standing rules governing the Annual Members' Business Meeting, including debate limits, speaker identification, and procedures for motions.
- Vote to approve 2025 Annual Members' Business Meeting Minutes
Dr. Hong called for a vote to approve the 2025 Annual Members' Business Meeting Minutes. There were no questions or discussions. *The minutes of the 2025 Annual Members' Business Meeting were approved via voice vote.*

Society Update

- SIR President's report
Dr. Lookstein reported on key society initiatives, including strong growth in residency match rates, advocacy successes related to procedure coding and CMS prior authorization limitations, expanded collaboration with international partners, and continued investment in the VIRTEX registry and the Future of IR strategic initiative. He also encouraged members to engage in advocacy efforts and support organized medicine through AMA membership, highlighted increased harmonization with global partners through initiatives such as World Interventional Radiology Day, and noted ongoing discussion of a global curriculum and collaboration opportunities connected to VIRTEX.
- SIR Foundation Chair's report
Dr. Clifford Weiss reported on the Foundation's initiatives, including progress in clinical trials support, consensus panels, grant funding, and mentorship programs such as SMIPS and GEMS. He noted strong engagement in these programs and their positive outcomes for trainees and early-career physicians. He also shared that the Foundation remains focused on sustainable stewardship of resources while continuing to distribute grants and awards in support of the specialty.
- SIR Treasurer's report
Dr. Raymond Liu presented the Treasurer's report and described the Society's strong financial position. He highlighted positive operating gains in FY25, successful fundraising efforts, cost efficiencies, and the strength of the Society's diverse revenue streams. He noted that while FY25 closed with a positive profit and loss position, FY26 is budgeted for a net loss due to continued strategic investments, primarily related to VIRTEX.

2026-2027

- The slate of SIR officers for 2026-2027 was announced and new board members and steering council members were introduced. Dr. Lookstein thanked outgoing members of leadership for their service and dedication.
- The slate of SIR Foundation officers for 2026-2027 was announced, and new members to the board were introduced. Dr. Weiss thanked outgoing members for their time and effort.
